# Thank you for your interest in Les Dames d'Escoffier Portland Chapter!

Les Dames d'Escoffier Portland (LDEP) works to contribute to the vitality of the region in three primary ways.

- 1. Provide women in the community (non-members) with scholarships and mentorship to help them succeed in food, beverage and hospitality careers.
- 2. Provide educational programs for members and community.
- 3. Support community projects and organizations that align with our guiding principles <u>https://ldei.org/about/</u>.

Participation requirements:

- A minimum of 5 years of experience in the food, beverage or hospitality fields.
- A commitment to 4 or more LDEI volunteer hours in the calendar year.
- Attendance at a minimum of 1 event or board meeting in the calendar year.
- Membership dues of \$180 per year, payable to Les Dames PDX.

Your membership gives you access to:

- Chapter events including mixers, skill-shares, panels, courses, fundraisers and more (some events do require nominal fees to cover costs or to raise funds).
- Networking, support, and educational opportunities with/by current chapter members.
- Access to LDEI members (many pioneers in their fields!) in the U.S. and around the world.

We believe that historical practices in the food, beverage and hospitality industries disproportionally deny access and exploit the most marginalized people in society. Hence, we aim to uplift women, including immigrant women, women of color, women from working class backgrounds, and women in the LGBTQ community as the valuable and integral parts of these industries that we truly are.

We strongly encourage applications from people with these identities or who are members of marginalized communities to apply.

Please note that we use the terms *women* or *Dames* to include those who self-identify as a woman or Dame.
